Private graveside services for Larry Ford Faulk, 73, of Hawkinsville, who passed away Sunday, January 31, 2021, in Taylor Regional Hospital, in Hawkinsville will be held Thursday, February 4, 2021, in Crest Lawn Memorial Park, in Atlanta.

Larry was born in Atlanta and was the son of the late Leon P. Ford and Florene Skipper Ford Faulk, and was raised by his adoptive father, Charlie Faulk. He was a graduate of Warner Robins High School, Class of 1965. Following high school, he attended the University of Georgia where he was a graduate of the Class of 1970. Larry began his teaching career in the Pulaski County School System as a Teacher and Administrator. He was a member of the Hawkinsville First United Methodist Church, Professional Association of Georgia Educators, Georgia Science Teachers Association, Kapp Delta Pi, and past president of the Pulaski County Association of Educators. He was preceded in death by a brother, Donald C. Ford.

He is survived by his care-givers, Cam and Amy H. Black, John Thomas Black and Nate Black, all of Hawkinsville; brother, Clyde (Kathy) Heath of Greensboro; sister, Geraldine F.
